Master's Scholarship Program

Empowering young women from Asia to become changemakers for the future.

The Ching Tien Foundation for Women invests deeply in aspiring women leaders from Asia. Our mission is to develop confident, global-minded leaders who will drive positive change in their communities and in the world. Our scholarship programs support young women to pursue advanced academic studies and leadership training in a global setting. Beyond scholarship funding, we offer mentorship, learning enrichment, and a powerful community of support — equipping women to thrive in higher education abroad and emerge as resilient leaders.

The Ching Tien Foundation's *Master's Scholarship Program* supports outstanding young women from Asia in pursuing master's degrees at international universities. The program aims to equip recipients with the mindset, confidence, and skills to become leaders in their professions and communities. In return, scholarship recipients commit to giving back through community engagement and volunteering, culminating in a capstone 'Pay It Forward' project — their first step in making a lasting impact.

Eligibility

To be considered, applicants must:

- Hold an undergraduate degree earned in Asia.
- Have been accepted into a master's program in Canada, the US, the UK, and other European countries.
- Have work experience gained during or after undergraduate studies.
- Have completed a minimum of 100 hours of volunteer work within the past three years.
- Demonstrate an impact-driven mindset and a strong commitment to giving back.

Special Consideration: As a registered Canadian charitable organization, the Foundation gives priority to applicants admitted to Canadian universities.

Scholarship Benefits

The Ching Tien Foundation Master's Scholarship Program is designed to create a lasting connection between the Foundation and each scholar, continuing well beyond the study period. Recipients benefit from:

- Scholarship funding of CAD 10,000 – CAD 25,000, usable for tuition and living expenses during the program.
- Access to academic advising and coaching as needed.
Learning opportunities from the Foundation in personal development, career planning, and leadership skills.
- Mentorship from the Foundation and other volunteer professionals
- In person participation in the annual Ching Tien Foundation Leadership Forum and summer retreat.
- Ongoing alumni engagement and post-graduation support.

Recipient Obligations

Scholarship recipients are expected to:

- Maintain above-average academic performance in their master's program.
- Learn the local cultural and engage with the local communities through volunteering at a chosen cause and submit a written report.
- Attend bi-weekly online learning sessions provided by the Foundation.
- Learn a new skill or hobby outside of academic studies.
- Act as an ambassador for the Foundation and take on volunteer roles to support its mission.
- After graduation, design and implement a 'Pay It Forward' project to apply learned leadership skills in support of the Foundation or their local community.
