Virtual Leadership Training Program

Empowering young women from Asia to become changemakers for the future.

The Ching Tien Foundation for Women invests deeply in aspiring women leaders from Asia. Our mission is to develop confident, global-minded leaders who will drive positive change in their communities and in the world. Our scholarship programs support young women to pursue advanced academic studies and leadership training in a global setting. Beyond scholarship funding, we offer mentorship, learning enrichment, and a powerful community of support – equipping women to thrive in higher education abroad and emerge as resilient leaders.

The Ching Tien Foundation's *Virtual Leadership Training Program* provides personal development and leadership learning opportunities to Asian women who are in their senior year undergraduate and graduate studies, and those who have started their career path. The Leadership Skills Program is led by a faculty of professional leadership training facilitators, and participants are guided to develop practical skills to enhance their leadership potential. The program is designed to motivate aspiring women leaders to step out of their comfort zone, master the skills and competencies essential for leadership today, and dare to lead.

Participation in this program is free of charge.

Format

- 5x virtual 120-minute modules.
- Weekly, Sundays 9:00am-11:00am, Beijing Time.
- Participants are requested to maintain a reflective journal to keep track of their learnings.
- Participants develop 1-to-3-year growth action plans, which will be presented at the final session of the program.

Program Goals

- Empower participants to develop bold, expansive leadership visions and career goals and take actionable steps to realize their ambitions.

- Enhance skills in critical thinking, visionary communication, influence, and strategic networking.
- Cultivate a purpose-driven mindset anchored in serving others and continuous self-discovery.
- Strengthen participants' abilities to lead effectively amid complexity including cultural differences, global issues, ethical challenges, and social impact demands.
